### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

For past half a century, the Conference has provided a forum for the exchange of views and experiences of scientists, investors, designers, contractors and representatives of construction administration in the field of widely understood safety of building structures. The Conference will consist of problem sessions, in which papers commissioned by the Conference Organizers will be presented, as well as thematic sessions covering papers submitted by participants and qualified by the Conference Scientific Committee.

### **CONFERENCE SCOPE**

- structural diagnostics and prevention of construction failures,
- analysis of the causes of construction disasters and accidents,
- post-failure repairs and reconstruction,
- evaluation and analysis of the design, construction and legislation processes for the safe operation of buildings,
- issues of revitalization of historic buildings and reconstruction of historic architectural complexes.

### **AUTHOR'S GUIDELINES**

Manuscripts accepted by the Conference Scientific Committee will be published as chapters in a scientific monograph (20 pts according to the Ministry of Science and Higher Education). In addition, extended abstracts in English will be published as conference materials. Each author submits the full text of the article in English (as a chapter of the monograph) and an extended abstract in English (for the conference materials). Selected papers will be qualified by the Scientific Committee for high-scoring journals.
